Numbers about Reading in the US

Illiterate adults in the US.	21%	Adults with literacy level 54% below sixth-grade.
Cost of low literacy rates in the US each year.	\$2.2B	Low literacy rates of people 4.3% who weren't born in US
Students who can't read proficiently in 4 th grade end up in jail.	67%	Enter kindergarten with skills 2-3 years lower than grade 20% level.
Drop out rates due to lack of literacy proficiency.	17%	Students not in school or working (often lack high school diploma/GED.


